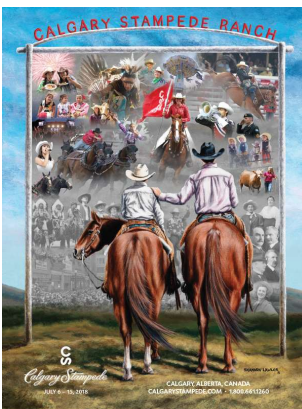
Where do we begin.... July in Calgary...

Interesting Facts about The Calgary Stampede:

- In 1886 the Calgary District and Agricultural Society held the first Exhibition. There was little more to Calgary than a CPR station, a North West Mounted Police post and about 1000 people. The Exhibition was an opportunity to share knowledge about practicing agriculture in the West
- The Exhibition's growth attracted national attention. In 1908, the federal government awarded Calgary the Dominion Exhibition, a travelling fair intended to highlight the country's various regions.
- In 1923, the first free Stampede breakfast was held at a campsite just outside the Canadian Pacific Railway station close to downtown Calgary. Jack Morton, a chuck wagon driver, invited his loved ones and visitors to enjoy free pancakes at the camp, creating a tradition that still exists today
